
state-wide organization with over 500 volunteers, provides training aware-ness that human trafficking has no boundaries, whether it is in labor or sex trafficking.

Officer Kyle said about 10 years ago a major shift was noticed due to easier access to social media. "Parents can't keep up with their kids access to the numerous social media sites."

"The accomplish base to the attention base is how many children now place their values." Officer Kyle noted that predators find it easy to fill the need that kids are looking to fill. In Mississippi Human Trafficking is

a felony for anyone using kids under the age of 18 due to the fact that children are more vulnerable to coercion. Children are always vulnerable and boys are more vulnerable than girls.

Statistics indicate the average age of human trafficking is 12-14 years old. Girls are 95% of the sex trade, however, boys are worth more money because they are less apt to testify


