### Mike Montgomery ARC of Mississippi

### WHAT IS ARC of MISSISSIPPI?

Mike Montgomery spoke to the Club about the ARC, which is the largest national community-based organization advocating for and serving people with intellectual and developmental disabilities and their families.

Mike has a disability resulting from a childhood injury and has devoted his adult career to advocating for disabled persons. Through a slide show presentation Mike gave a wonderful overview of the ARC organization and how it has made a change in the rights intellectual and developmental challenged persons.

"ARC, founded in 1950, was started as a grassroots movement of families working vigilantly to create services for children and adults who were being denied day care, educational opportunities and work programs. ARC programs are implemented through its working with its 700 federation of state and local chapters to create a network of human service agencies ensuring they have the strongest civil rights advocates promoting and protecting their needs at all levels" explained Montgomery.

Locally, Mike is tasked to assist disabled persons in obtaining employment opportunities based on the individuals interest. Several slides where of individuals which were placed by matching their interest to a local employer, such as...a coin vending machine technician; a deaf and blind individual with other physical

handicaps interested in medical now working in a medical facility in the instrument sterilization unit; and, a young man interested in law enforcement has worked with different sheriffs in the Jackson Co. Sheriff Dept. ensuring appropriate documents are correctly filed in the case files.
