## **Singing River Health System Gulfport Expanding Orthopedic Services**

Singing River Health System (SRHS) in Gulfport is the getting the word out of their first Orthopedic Team of Philip Myers, D.O. and Jay Smith, CRNP. This team's specialty is to manage pain treatment without surgery or using minimally-invasive surgical procedures.

Dr. Myers's procedures and conditions treated include arthroscopic surgery, carpal tunnel, hand surgery, orthopedics, sport injuries, sports medicine, total joint replacement and trauma surgery.

"Hip replacement is the #2 patient satisfaction surgery, with heart surgery being #1" states Myers. He further explained how his procedure of minimally-invasive anterior total hip arthroplasty allows patients to recover more quickly after major hip replacement surgery.

The second on this team is Certified Registered Nurse Practitioner Jay Smith. Smith has been a Nurse Practitioner in the field of orthopedics since 2005. Smith also completed the National Institute of First Assist training in 2012.

Together this team will assess injuries and conditions to decide the best pain management treatment plan for the patient without surgery. However, if surgery is required much of it can be done, such as total hip and knee replacement, by the means of minimally invasive procedures and robotically.

A questions and answer time provided some very interesting questions from the Club members.
