There is no age limit, no gender preference, and no race is safe from those profiting from human trafficking. Human Trafficking currently produces \$150 Billion a year and is the #2 crime in

Human Trafficking currently produces \$150 Billion a year and is the #2 crime in America, second only to drug trafficking. Those at risk are mostly children or young adults and once they're in trafficking they do not have a voice.
