Dear Mr. Ross and Esteemed Members of the Biloxi Lions Club,

Melissa Batia Williams is, in my opinion, Mother of the Year. I am nominating my niece because, truth be told, she should be declared Mother of the Year for the last 18 years!

Melissa's first child, John Grayson, was born on April 28, 2002 at just 26 weeks gestation, weighing less than two pounds. After an excruciating four months in the hospital and suffering multiple life-threatening scares and medical emergencies, "Grayson" was discharged to his home and the care of his loving parents. Her understanding, love, and empathetic nature, along with her steady demeanor and fair and equal treatment of all she encounters, demonstrate to her children how a person of character lives. Throughout all of these years and dedicated involvement in her children's schools and sports endeavors, Grayson and Brayden have remained her top priority and their formation as children, adolescents, and eventually adults her true mission in life.
