Exosomes, Stem Cell Therapy for Orthopedic Injuries, Anti-Aging, and Degenerative Diseases

Dr. Lawrence Bougeois, Chiropractic Physician at GenNex Healthcare LLC, provided a very informative slide show presentation explaining the benefits of healthy stem cells, exosomes, and how they can be used in pain management.

After evaluating the extent of a patient's pain complaint, they may use of the minimally invasive procedure exosome therapy. Studies have shown the therapy can help alleviate, or totally eliminate, pain associated with orthopedic injuries, anti-aging or degenerative diseases. The exosomes have shown anti-inflammatory potential to reduce inflammation in conditions leading to a faster healing response.
