He started his talk as he has at previous Club visits by complimenting the Mississippi Gulf Coast folk as being very welcoming and supportive of the coast military installations and their personnel. Brian stated "when it comes to BRAC (Base Realignment & Closure) how well a military facility community relationship is looked at closely on the BRAC report."



salon, the gym, and play grounds.

The NCBC also gave aid to the USS Tripoli with its over 1000 sailors and personnel docked in Pascagoula while awaiting its maiden deployment. A COVID19 breakout aboard ship meant that the affected personal had to be quarantined separately, fed separately, medically treated separately and provided with virtual activities to keep occupied.

When asked about Hurricane Laura assistance to Louisiana, Brian indicated that the NCBC Gulfport has not been asked to participate in rescue and recovery efforts at this time. But all it would take would be a request submitted by the local authorities for their assistance and a crew would be sent over. The NCBC did receive a request and gave assistance following Hurricane Michael which hit the western coast of Floridan near Panama City in 2018. And, of course, they gave more than just assistance 15 years ago when Hurricane Katrina slammed into our own back yard in August 2005.
