Scheduled speaker for 9/9/2020, T.J. Maury—Fire Chief NCBC, was unable to attended the meeting due to preparation for the 9/11 observances at the Seabee Base. Pitch hitting for Chief Maury was Chaplain Mark Torres and Training Officer Katie Morrison. Chief Maury will speak at a later date.

Chaplain Torres explained how the services in the Chaplain Corps is now to 1)Provide faith services, 2) Facilitate religious needs for personnel of other faiths, 3) Care for all sailors and Marine personnel, and 4) Advise Commanders on to meet possible needs of personnel under their command. Torres went on to state that a lot of attention has been shifted to focus on the younger generation, 18-25 year-olds, during the COVID19 pandemic. "Since religion is not on the forefront with younger sailors Chaplains must reestablish a relationship with common ground" stated Torres.

Installation Training Officer Katie Morrison's duties are to help draft and facilitate 56 page scripted Drill Packages for such drills for an active shooter, bomb threats, etc. for the NCBC facilities from Florida to Texas and north to Tennessee.

Morrison explained the necessity of these drills in keeping navy personnel conditioned should anyone of the situations arise homeland or abroad.
