Congressman Mike Ezell's 1st 100 Days in Office

It is hard to realize that just over 12 months ago Jackson County Sheriff Mike Ezell spoke to the Biloxi Lions about his accomplishments as serving as the Jackson Co. Sheriff.

Today he shared his accomplishments and his ongoing service to his 742,632 constituents as the US Representative of 4th Congressional District of MS (southern most 11 counties in MS) during his first 12 months in office. Joining Congressman Ezell was his District Deputy Director Julie Miller, from his Gulfport District office.

"I was elected to serve by the people of south MS and I will do that to the best of my ability" states Rep. Ezell. He named a few of the many ways his office has assisted constituents with issues important to their lives such as obtaining passports being held up at the State Department; obtaining a 102 yr. old WWII veteran his medals and awards he was entitled to receive for his service; working on getting the City of Picayune an permanent Post Office facility since theirs was destroyed over 2 years ago; getting The Army Corps of Engineers to include South Mississippi in decisions made in the future regarding the opening of the Bonnet Carre Spillway; appealed to the Army Corps of Engineers to dredge the Gulfport Port Authority channel 10' deeper to open the Port as an major shipping Port; working with the Truckers Association in getting road infrastructure upgraded to the Port because the friendly Gulfport atmosphere truckers experience; and getting critical funding for both KAFB and Camp Shelby for facility upgrades.

He expressed that his previous careers as Chief of Police and as Sheriff brought the experience that is the most important in serving in the US House of Representatives and that is forging relationships with his fellow Colleagues to make things work.

Important legislative bills he mentioned that are important to are: Officially end the COVID Emergency which has \$30M available; Passed in March: Lower Energy Gas Act; Passed in May: Secure the Borders Act; Overturned the ATF Pistol Brace Act; Requires the Veterans Administration to cut through the red tape veterans go through to get their benefits; and worked on the Short Term Deployment bill where college credits would not lost by students serving military reservist should they be called up for active duty deployment during a college term.

In closing he reiterated his desire to continuing to serve South MS by qualifying for re-election on 1/3/2024.
