Cassidy Anderson, Chancery Court Public Guardian

What does a Chancery Court Public Guardian do? Cassidy Anderson, a Gulfport Attorney, visited the Biloxi Club to explain the duties are for the Public Guardian in the Harrison County Chancery Court system.

Anderson, a practicing attorney in Gulfport since 2008,was appointed by the Harrison County Board of Supervisors Public Guardian in January 2023, so just over a year in this position. According to Anderson a Public Guardian provides a service to persons unable to properly care for themselves or who are unable to manage their finances. The person can be an elderly without a family member who can handle their affairs, an incapacitated adult that is experiencing mental health or drug addiction issues, or a minor.

His duties include, but are not limited to: acting as the Conservator for indigent folk, defender in Mental Health or Drug/Alcohol commitments, liquidates assets (if necessary) to cover medical expenses for elderly in nursing homes, and to act as the Attorney ad litem to represent a child during a legal action, such as in a divorce, in a parental termination, or child-abuse cases.

Anderson smiled as he described a room at the Harrison County Court House next to his office. It is filled with age appropriate toys, stuffed animals, games, and a small stuff couch. It is in this room he makes friends with the children that must come through the Chancery Court system. Anderson says he must gain the child's trust so what better way to do that but just to sit with them or get down on the floor and play.

As a conservator, his supervises the financial affairs of an adult who is found by the Court to be incapable of doing so themselves. Anderson further explained that he have to account for every penny of the person's assets, income and public assistance benefits and file a monthly report to the Court on the person's behalf. And, sometimes, I make decisions about medical care, food, clothing, and where the person will live.

In closing Anderson states that while he stays very busy he is extremely satisfied in the service this office provides.
