Baylee Beightol, Miss New South

Being very familiar with the Miss Mississippi Franchise with the three titles the Biloxi Lions Club sponsorship can offer, the Miss Gulf Coast, the Miss South Mississippi and the Miss Biloxi, our speaker today brought a new prospective to our speaker's platform.

Baylee Beightol joined the United States Air Force at age 17 and is an Air Force Reservist currently on Active Duty at Keesler Air Force Base. She obtained a degree in Business at the University of Southern Mississippi but her love is being an aircraft payload specialist with the Air Force.

Being recently crowned Miss New South in Hattiesburg, Baylee's platform for her bid as the next Miss Mississippi has much to do with her motto being "Your past does not define your present." Her personal history plays a huge part of her platform as she raised in a home with an incarcerated parent when she was a very young child.

She explains she was 13 when her parent came home and how hard it was to become a family again. Not only was it difficult for the parent to get back in society without a job it was also difficult for her to accept the parent because as she states "my parent left when I was so young and I did not know how to be with them."

As she grew older she said her childhood family circumstances of life after incarceration of just surviving and keeping a family together she realized she wanted to give HOPE for a change to others with her same family experience. Thus her platform is to develop a plan for a 501C3 nonprofit and seek a partnership with the Department of Corrections. The organization will be there to help the over 70% families of broken homes following the incarceration of a family member so that re-entry back to the family and society can be more successful.

Baylee said she has learned that one of the largest obstacles after incarcerator's release has been obtaining a valid birth certificate. "Without a valid birth certificate you can not get a valid drivers license and without a drivers license you cannot get to a place of employment unless there is convenient public transportation. Having gainful employment is what is most re-entries desire. Without a job most will return to their old habits and will most likely end going back to prison." There are other issues that she feels could be addressed and will formulate in her plan of action for the organization.

After a very lively question and answer session Lion Jerry Dodge presented Baylee with a Lions Pen.


