ARE YOU READY FOR SOME CRUISIN'?

If you were on the MS Gulf Coast in 1996 you may remember the new fall event being promoted as 'Cruisin' the Coast'. For 4 days in October it was so cool to see vintage car and truck enthusiast cruising their pride and joys up and down Hwy 90 along the beach.

But according to Woody Bailey, the Executive Director of Cruisin' the Coast, it wasn't just a fluke that vintage vehicles showed up on the Coast for those 4 days in October. It was a year in the making by local businessmen and the tourism folk to bring an event here that would help boast the coast economy slowed after the Labor Day weekend. The organizers loosely patterned this event off a vintage car event held in Reno, Nevada.

That first year 374 vehicles were registered and fast forward to 2022 where the registration number went over 9600 registered. And, add at least 5000 plus vintage vehicles arrive to cruise that are not registered. Then add the people who come to the coast just to see all those vintage cars and trucks at the many different scheduled events from Bay St. Louis t Pascagoula and Moss Point.

But with any major event that is spread out over 40 miles through 3 counties and involves all counties' major cities there is going to be growing pains, particularly in traffic congestion. Woody said that it is a huge concern but that his committee, the Cruisin' Krewe, addresses the issue by scheduling the cruise-in events for each city on specified days so that the participants and viewers can pick and choice which location they want to attend on a particular day.

Would you say that in 26 years this event has added an economic impact to the three MS Coastal counties? Woody says that the impact study that is taken every 5 years of the event indicates a growth of 27% increase. In 2021, the 25th Cruisin' Anniversary year, the revenue for the three coastal counties was \$33.1M. Many would answer with a resounding YES!

So are you ready to be part of America's largest block party? If so, put October 1-8 oon your calendar and be prepared to party hardy with 9600 plus other vintage car and truck enthusiast and visitors to the Mississippi Gulf Coast.
