Does American Cancer Society Do?

ACS was founded in 1913 as the American Society of Cancer Control (ASCC). It was reorganized in 1945 to the American Cancer Society (ACS) as a 501 (c)(3) organization to raise public awareness, funding for cancer research and funding for local cancer programs.

Whitney Ott spoke to the Biloxi Club and share about what is currently happening with the ACS with a short slideshow presentation.

To date over \$5B has been invested in cancer research and development of cancer fight treatment plans; over 490K patient rides to treatment or physician facilities; over 500K of free lodging nights for patients and caregivers; answered 1.4M calls from individuals with cancer questions; and over 135M page visits to the CANCER.ORG website.

Ott said one of the biggest help to cancer patients and their families have been the opening of HOPE LODDGES, lodging facility funded by ACS near treatment facilities. Stay at Hope Lodge is free.

Joining Ott was Kelly Lamb, a co-worker with ACS that works mainly with the ACS CAN Program, a leading cancer advocacy organization which works on the legislative side of the American Cancer Society awareness mission. ACS CAN also raising funding to help with the cost of issue campaigns for lawmakers. However, donations to ACS CAM is non-tax deductible.
