We are proud to present Biloxi's Outstanding Citizen 2023 Honorable Andrew "FoFo" Gilich Mayor of Biloxi

An active member of Our Lady of Fatima Catholic Church and a member of several Biloxi civic and community organizations. He is perhaps best known for his leadership in the Slavic Benevolent Association, known as the Croatian-American Cultural Society, or locally as the "Slavonian Lodge".

Gilich has overseen the organizations

annual golf tournament grown from its humble beginnings 47 years ago with a handful of participants to what today is billed as "the planet's largest four-ball tournament" attracting 1,100 golfers from across the country to play on six local golf courses and enjoy four days of social events including sit-down dinners for more than 2,000 people.

"FoFo" was tagged with his nickname as a young toddler because of his affinity for "ack and the Beanstalk" ("fee-fi-fo-fum"), and, as is the case with most nicknames for people in Biloxi, it stuck.
