

NASA's Artemis Program...To the Moon and Beyond



If you grew up on the Mississippi Gulf Coast you are very aware of the large parcel of land in Hancock County known as the NASA's Stennis Space Center (SSC.) With over 138,000 acres it is the 2nd largest of the 10 NASA centers in the U.S. in terms of geographic size.

It is NASA's largest rocket testing facility and has over 50 local, state, national, private, and public companies and agencies utilizing the site for their rocket components and testing programs.

Karma Snyder, the NASA/Stennis Space Center Range Safety Manager, has been keeping the Biloxi Lions updated on the SSC different programs and projects over the years. Continued on page 4....



NASA's Artemis Program...To the Moon and Beyond continued...

Karma's power point presentation walked us through the new all the new SSC rocket testing and development of the ARTEMIS Mission Moon to Mars Exploration. On a side note, on April 4th NASA announced the Artemis II Crew, 4 astronauts which will be the first crew to fly to the moon in half a century. Apollo 17 was the last moon mission in 1972. By the way Artemis is the mythological goddess of the Moon and twin sister of Apollo.

But how will they get to the moon? Aboard the Artemis II with the Space Launch System (SLS) Rocket Block 1. The SLS rockets are the ones that were tested Stennis. "The SLS Rocket is the most powerful rocket ever built with 8.8m pounds of thrust, 1.3m greater than the Apollo Saturn V. Artemis will fly further than any other spacecraft built for humans" according to NASA in Nov. 2022.

According to Karma's power point timeline, the Stennis Space Center has been in the forefront of the SLS RS-25 Engine testing since January 2015. Nine short years ago when she visited the Biloxi

Club shortly after the testing, she said that NASA's plans were to put humans back on the Moon by 2024. We were in awe that not only were we were going back to the Moon, but that the moon would be a staging area for further advancements to continue to Mars. Well, here we are...in November 2024 the Crew of Artemis 2 will be launched into space for a new journey to the Moon. And, to think, a large piece of the journey, the RS-25 SLS rocket, was tested in a facility located in our neighboring Hancock County.

The next vital component in NASA's Artemis program will be the Gateway. Gateway will serve as a multi-purpose outpost orbiting the Moon that provides essential support for long-term human return to the lunar surface. NASA is working with commercial and international partners to establish the Gateway.

Congratulations and Godspeed to new crew of the Artemis 2 mission: Commander Reid Wiseman; Pilot Victor Glover; Mission Specialist Christina Hammock Koch; and Mission Specialist Jeremy Hansen.
