Nominate your father for 'Father of the Year.'

If your father lives or works in the City of Biloxi, he is eligible to be nominated for the Biloxi's 'Father of the Year' Award for 2023.

The father who receives this honor shall:

- 1) Be a father who is currently acting in a fatherly capacity to children in his own household. From infants to college students, foster children, adopted children, stepchildren, biological children, grandchildren, etc.
- 2) Be a father who participates in and supports the activities of his children.
- 3) Be recognized as a father who cares about the youth in the community.
- 4) Be a father who puts his children first and helps create a unified family unit.

In addition:

- 1) The character of the children should be considered as a testament of the father's guidance regarding ethics and morals generally accepted by the community.
- 2) The achievements of the most recent year will receive the highest consideration with achievements over the children's lifetime also being considered.
- 3) His involvement beyond his workplace and family unit in the community and the examples her sets for his children should be considered.

The finalist will be honored with a luncheon in their honor at noon on Wednesday June 14, 2023, at the Maritime Seafood and Industry Museum.
