What's New at the MS Aguarium?

Well...the Changing Tides Exhibit and a new marketing strategy...the welcoming of Patrick Pearson, VP of Sales and Marketing.

Patrick joined the MSAQ in March 2023 in time for the final preparations for the unveiling of the Changing Tides Exhibit, located in the new 7,000 sq.ft. indoor exhibit hall. The exhibit ribbon cutting took place on August 24, 2023.

He highlighted the key features of the MSAQ, which opening in 2020, with a very interesting power point presentation starting with the 501c3's mission statement. "We exist to: Be the window to the waters of Mississippi, the Gulf Coast and beyond, fostering a sense of appreciation by encouraging guests to explore majestic environments and play an active role in research and conservation efforts...from brown-to-blue and beyond..."

"We are very committed to animal welfare" Patrick indicated with the slide of the Aquarium's associations with the Alliance of Marine Mammal Parks & Aquariums, the IMATA (International Marine Animal Trainers' Association), American Humane, and The Association of Zoos & Aquarium.

The MSAQ's Educational offerings are designed to Inspire minds-Create connections-Make a difference...through Field Trips, Summer Camps, Virtual Learning, Outreach, Professional Development, Project SAIL, Accessibility & Inclusion, MSAQ U/Lecture Series, Day Camps, and Birthday Parties/Sleepovers.

The facility has indoor and outdoor exhibits, a giant Wall of Wonder for viewing their large tank on a large scale, one of only a few elevated and 360 degree tunnels through their large tank, and now Changing Tides-their first expansion, since opening in 2020. This indoor exhibit hall features 23 new exhibits showing a cold climate exhibit a rainforest exhibit warm water exhibit, and brown water exhibit.

exhibit, a rainforest exhibit, warm water exhibit, and brown water exhibit. Since coming out of the main COVID19 pandemic the MSAQ saw over 230,000 visitors in 2023. Upcoming promotions Patrick explained will be seasonable monthly promotions such as in every weekend in October: Boo at MSAQ featuring the Sea Cave Black Light Maze and a Costumed alligator scavenger hunt. November: 1st 2 weekends Mermaids and Pirates with VIP Mermaid Breakfast; \$10 off weekday admission for MS residents; Black Friday Sale-Annual Pass Bundle; and the annual Otter Trotter on Thanksgiving Day. December: Surfin' Santa for two days in December. Patrick shared so much more of the excitement that the new Changing Tides ex-
