# About Kagyud Shedrupling

The Kagyud Shedrupling was setup by Khenpo Thinley Dorji with the objectives to:-

- provide education to children of low-income households
- to spread and uphold the Teachings of Buddha
- restore the Drikung Kagyud lineage in Bhutan.

Within the short period of 3 years, the intake of monks has increase from 5 to 30 and there are still very strong requests from families to send their children to the Institute.

# **Our Situation Now**

Since founded in 2020, Kagyu Shedrupling has been operating from rented premises and is faced with the following issues.





## Poor Living Condition

We have exceeded the maximum capacity of the current premise. The monks are cramped into small makeshift spaces.





## Insufficient Facilities

The current premise was not designed to house so many people. Hence there is insufficient facilities such as toilets, classrooms and proper dining hall.



# Temporarily Halt Intake

Every year there are many requests from families to send their children to us but we are **unable to take in more monks now** due to space constraints.

Children are missing out on the opportunity to receive education.







## High Operating Cost

High operating cost from having to pay **monthly rental**.



# Moving Forward

We are blessed to have received many supports from generous sponsors and have gathered sufficient fund to acquire a plot of land at Paro Bhutan, meant for the construction of our own buildings.

Upon completion of the development, we will be able to increase our intake from 30 to 80 monks and the monks will have a better environment to live and study in.

  - 1 Dinning Hall
  - 18 Bedrooms

The Institute is currently operating from a rented house and has reached the maximum capacity of the premise.

With the new building, we will be able to increase the in-take of monks from 30 to 80 and solve the problems of water supply and toilets provision.

Your support will directly improve the living conditions of the monks and allow more children to receive monastic education.





# Benefit Two

The young monks are like seedlings nourished by Buddha-Dharma. When they complete their studies, they will be like trees, that will spread the seeds of Dharma to more sentient beings.

By supporting the education of the sanghas, one is directly helping with the spread of Dharma and hence enable Buddhism to flourish and benefits more people..





# Benefit Three

The Drikung Kagyu Lineage was first established in Bhutan when one of Lord Jigten Sumgön's heart-disciples, Nyo Gyelwa Lhanangpa Sanggye Rinchen built a fortress called "Do Ngon Dzong" in the year 1216.

Nyo brought to Bhutan the teachings of Lord Jigten Sumgon and established many monasteries and hermitages that existed for centuries.

However, by the 17th century, all that remained in Bhutan of this tradition are some vague historical memories and ancient ruins.
