
**NOTICE OF BUSINESS MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Well #3 total usage applied for is 10,000,000 gallons or 30.69 acre-feet annually. The purpose of proposed use is to fill ponds that are used for irrigation of trees.
