

9. Receive and possibly take action to approve the operating permit an agriculture/irrigation well for James E. Trevathan Jr., located at 653 CR 2804, Alto TX. Total usage applied for is 33,000,000 gallons or 101.27 acre-feet annually at an estimated rate of 150 gallons per minute.
10. Receive and possibly take action to approve the operating permit for Public Water Supply well #7 for the City of Rusk, located at located at 2082 W. Sixth St., Rusk, TX. Total usage applied for is 89,000,000 gallons or 270.13 acre-feet annually at an estimated rate of 500 gallons per minute. Well #7 replaces plugged well #4.

11. Receive and possibly take action to approve the operating permit for irrigation well #1 for Pine Bliss LLC, located at 8351 FM 315 S., Larue, TX. Total usage applied for is 3,000,000 gallons or 9.21 acre-feet annually at an estimated rate of 420 gallons per minute.

13. Receive update on applications for well permits from Pine Bliss LLC and Redtown Ranch Holdings LLC.
