PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE – DRILLING PERMIT

A HEARING ON THE BELOW-IDENTIFIED DRILLING PERMIT WILL BE HELD ON MARCH 19, 2026, 1:00 PM AT NTVGCD, 501 DEVEREUX ST., SUITE 201, JACKSONVILLE TEXAS 75766.

Drilling Permit: Well #3, Lakeshore Utility Co., Inc, located on FM 1214, Caney, Henderson County, TX , for the purposes of Public Water Supply use.

Recommendation by General Manager: The General Manager has determined that the application is administratively complete and recommends for consideration by the Board of Directors at the Public Hearing a drilling permit to authorize maximum annual groundwater production from this well in gallons as shown below:

Pumping Capacity: 3,000,000 gallons or 9.21 acre-feet annually at the rate of 50 gallons per minute.

Potential Maximum Rate of Production per Year: 26,280,000 gals.
