All rehearsals will take place in our own venue The Bow Centre in Horley. This has 3 studio spaces which means we can utilise the rehearsals to ensure that there is no wasted time and there will even be space to practise all with mirrors. It is for this reason that we will be rehearsing for a shorter rehearsal period of just 13 weeks.
