Sealed proposals will be received by **City of Beaverton, 128 Saginaw Street, Beaverton, MI 48612**, until **11:00 a.m., Tuesday, September 29th, 2026**, and then publicly opened for work including the following estimated quantities and appurtenances:

- Tonkin Street Reconstruction (M-18 to the West End) including sanitary, storm sewer, roadway, sidewalk– 2,730 LF
- Tonkin Street Extension – including necessary infrastructure – 1,200 LF
- Brown Street – SIPP Concrete Lining of Existing 36" Storm Sewer – 241 LF
- Church Street – Storm Sewer / Drainage Improvements – 1,000 LF

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a certified check or bidder's bond in the amount of 5% of the bid. Checks shall be drawn payable to **City of Beaverton** as security for the acceptance of the Contract and subject to the conditions stated in the Instructions to Bidders. The **Beaverton** City Council reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, to waive informalities or errors in the bidding process, and to accept any bid deemed to be in the best interest of the city, including bids that are not for the lowest amount. The city will first give all due consideration to bids from Contractors that are familiar with the city's infrastructure system, experienced with the city's standards and overall city project process, and that are local to the Great Lakes Bay Region.
