Registration Information

- All new owners WILL be given AKC registration, if the pup is out of AKC registered parents.
- If for any reason you are not given papers upon time of purchase, you will be given them upon completion of payments, or as soon as we receive them from AKC.
 - Special liters (out of an imported sire/dam) may take a little longer to receive papers for AKC. Papers will be mailed to you ASAP.
- Full Registration vs. Limited Registration: Full registration is simply breeding rights. Limited registration is still having AKC papers in your name, but owners are not allowed to breed their puppy.

Our Contract and Requirements

Breach of contract fee: \$2500.00 In any cases of breach of contract, you have 8 months to cover the fees and costs listed. You will also be required cover all of our attorney fees, and the court costs.. Any slandering or degradation of Golden Meadow Ranch, our business, or our family, will result in a breach of contract.

- Your puppy/dog MUST be kept up to date on his/her vaccinations and have regular trips to the veterinarian.
- You MUST register your puppy, with the paperwork given, within the first 2 months of receiving bringing him/her home.
- If the new owner can no longer keep their puppy/dog:
 - Contact us first. We have first right to refusal.
 - If you don't already have an excellent home lined up, we may help you find one!
- If a puppy/dog has been mistreated in anyway (neglect, abuse, ect.) it will result in a breach of contract fee. Our #1 goal is to make sure every pup we sell, is a family member.
- All new families must be pre-qualified, and meet the following requirements:
 - Puppy/dog will never be locked up in a kennel/crate/small dog run for long periods of time, or put on a chain/leash and left outside in the weather.

- Our pups are NOT meant to be kennel dogs. They
 deserve to be treated as a family member. For example,
 you cannot leave them chained outside for a week
 because you decided to go on vacation. You may
 however, leave them in a backyard, or a run large
 enough for them to get plenty of exercise, with plenty of
 food, water, and shelter from the weather.
- New owners must have the time to care for the puppy/dog and they must have a yard big enough for the dog to run and play in, or the puppy/dog must get plenty of exercise daily.
- You must stay in contact with us as the pups grows and matures.

• LIMITED REGISTRATION:

- Pup must be spayed or neutered by the age of 9 months. We want our pups to go to homes, and to become part of the family.
 - The majority of pups that are from an accidental or improperly planned breedings end up in the shelter, as strays, with households that don't treat them as family, or with significant health issues.
- Accidental litters result in a breach of contract fee, as well as you pay us \$500 per puppy that was produced (live or stillborn) out of the puppy/dog we sold you. (For example, if your dog produces 4 puppies, you pay \$2500.. plus \$500×4 which is a grand total of \$4500.00)

 If there is suspicion of an "accidental" litter, we require that you allow us to DNA test every puppy in the litter, as well as the dog we sold you.

• FULL REGISTRATION:

 Pups sold with full registration may be bred. However, your puppy or dog is not to be bred until the age of 2 years old.
 Breeding before the specified age will result in a breach of contract.

Our Guarantee

All of our puppies that come from Golden Meadow Ranch, come with a 2 year health guarantee against any genetic related illness, (hip dysplasia, ect.) if issued by a licensed veterinarian. NO refunds, we will provide you with a replacement puppy (due to the fact that almost half of the cases of hip/elbow issues are due to environmental factors and not genetics). Each and every puppy will be up to date on vaccinations, dewormed, be properly socialized, mostly paper trained, and come with their AKC registration paperwork (if they have any).

Guarantee Validations:

Giving your new best friend NuVet is MANDATORY until the age of 2 years. Labs are mostly done growing by the time they hit 2 years old. NuVet supports joint growth, bone structure, and ear and eye development, to name just a few!

- If the circumstance arises, and your puppy does have a genetic issue and you want a replacement puppy, you must provide:
 - Proof the pup has been giving NuVet the entire they have been in your care, until he/she is 2 years old.
 - Keep receipts and bottles for every purchase.
 - X-rays/paperwork must be sent to the Orthopedic
 Foundation for Animals (OFA) to be examined, and the results from OFA forward to us.
 - Vaccination records, as well as licensed veterinarian visits.
