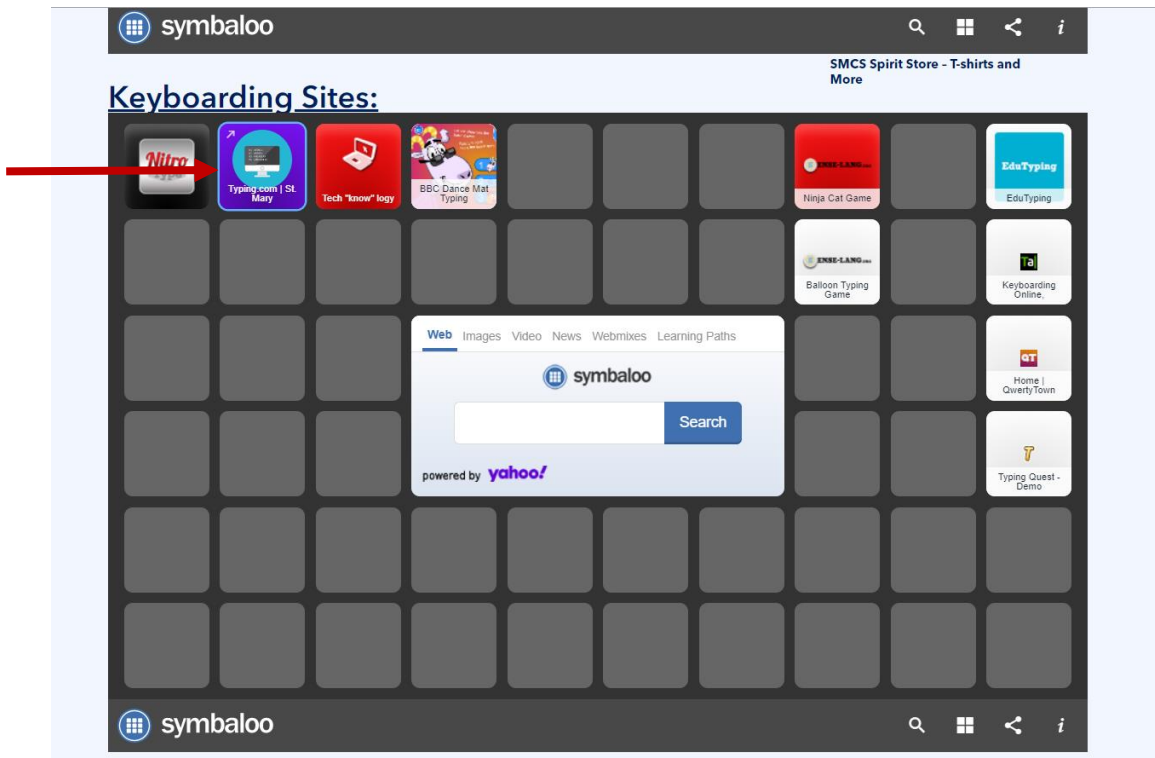
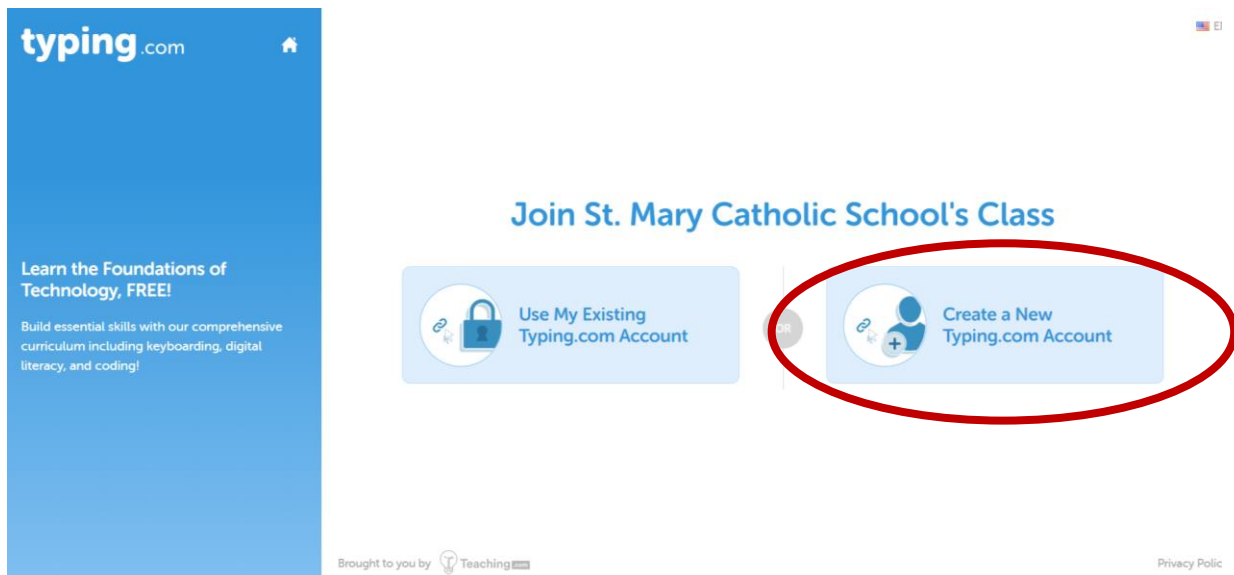


Creating and Using an Account for the First Time on Typing.com | St. Mary

Start on our stmarylc.org/library page, but scroll down to the second grid, titled Keyboarding. Click on the second block in the first row, "Typing.com | St. Mary".



You will see this screen. Click on the "Create a New Typing.com Account" button.



You will be directed to the sign-in page. Fill in the information there. Please note that there is a check box at the bottom to verify that a parent is with the child creating the account and directing the child to create it. (It's a federal law for children under 13. Unfortunately, many sites don't bother with it.)

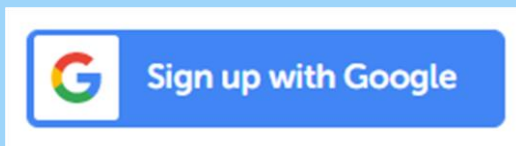

Click on the yellow "Sign Up" button.

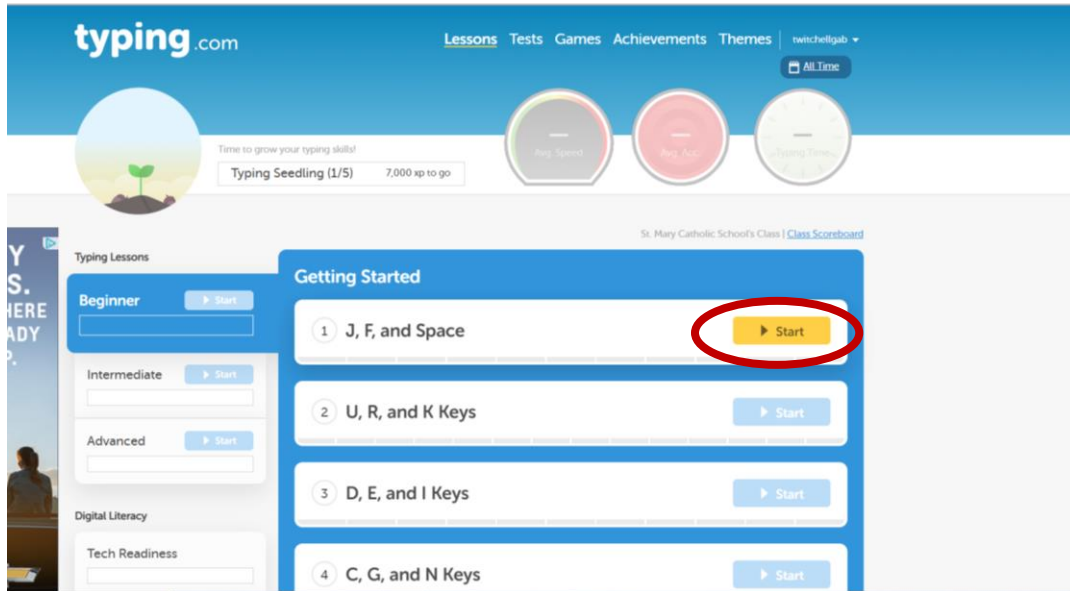
NOTE: If someone else already has that username, the field will turn red and it will ask you to choose another username. Create something unique that you can remember.

Alternate account creation:

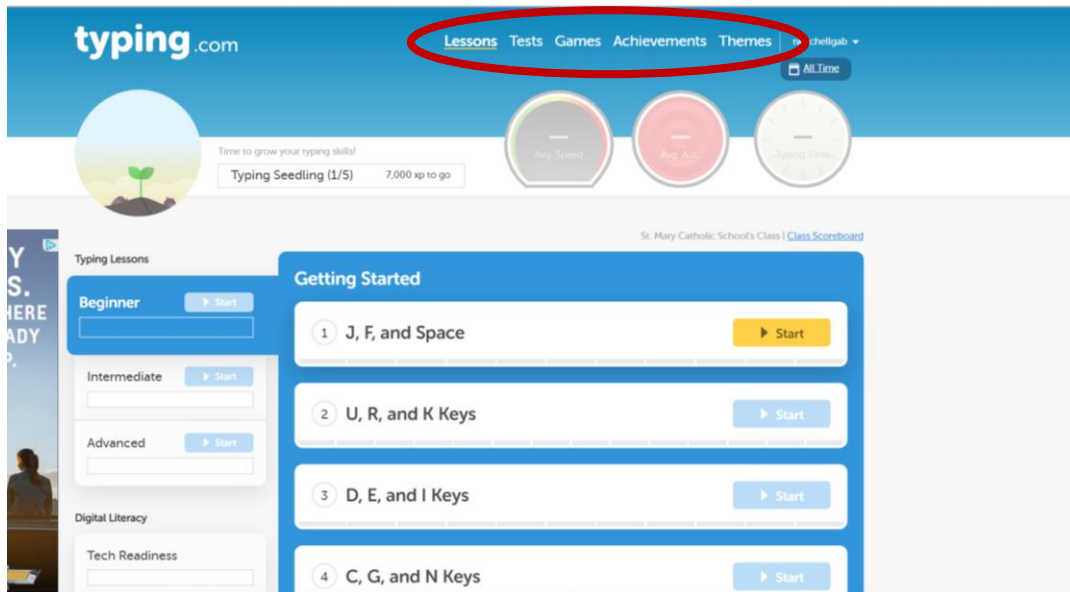

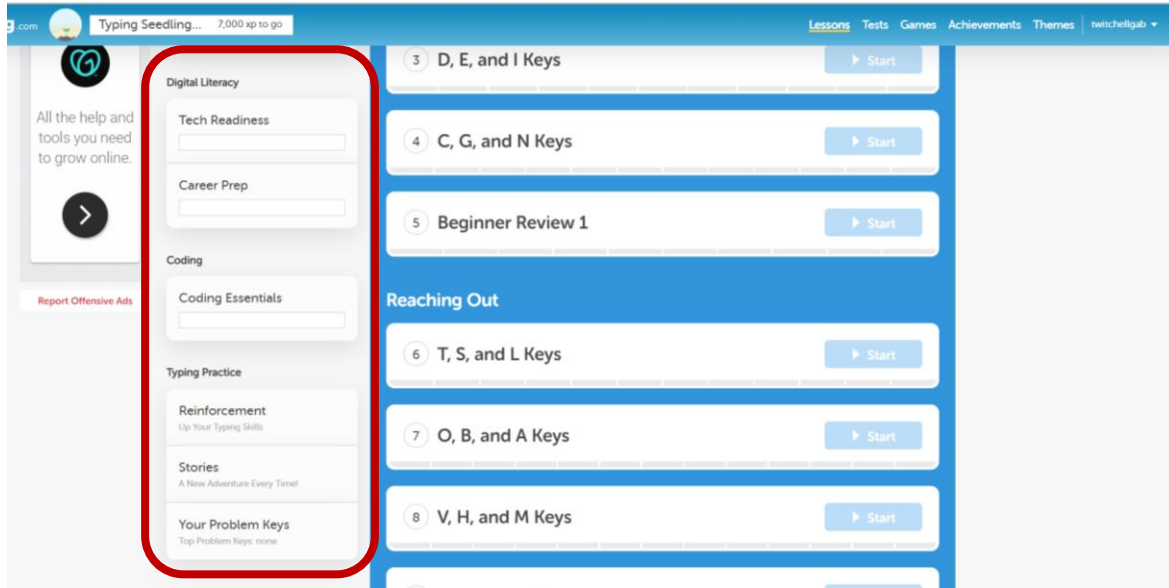

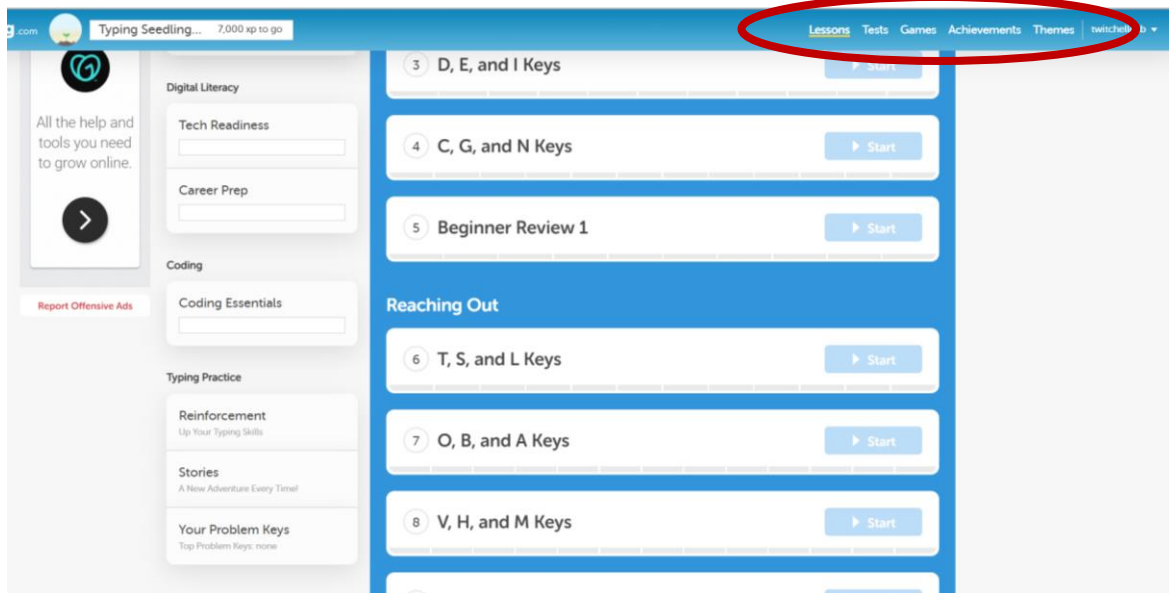
Links to other activities (tests, etc.) are across the top.



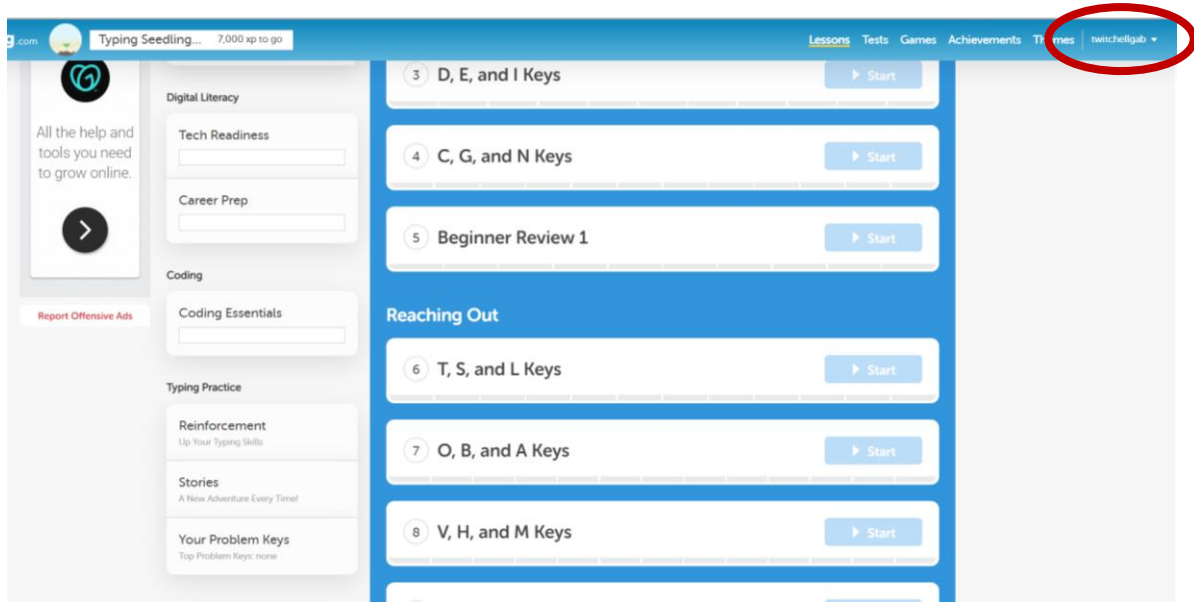
Links to Digital Literacy and Coding lessons, plus extra typing practice are found along the left-hand side menu. You'll have to scroll down to see them all.



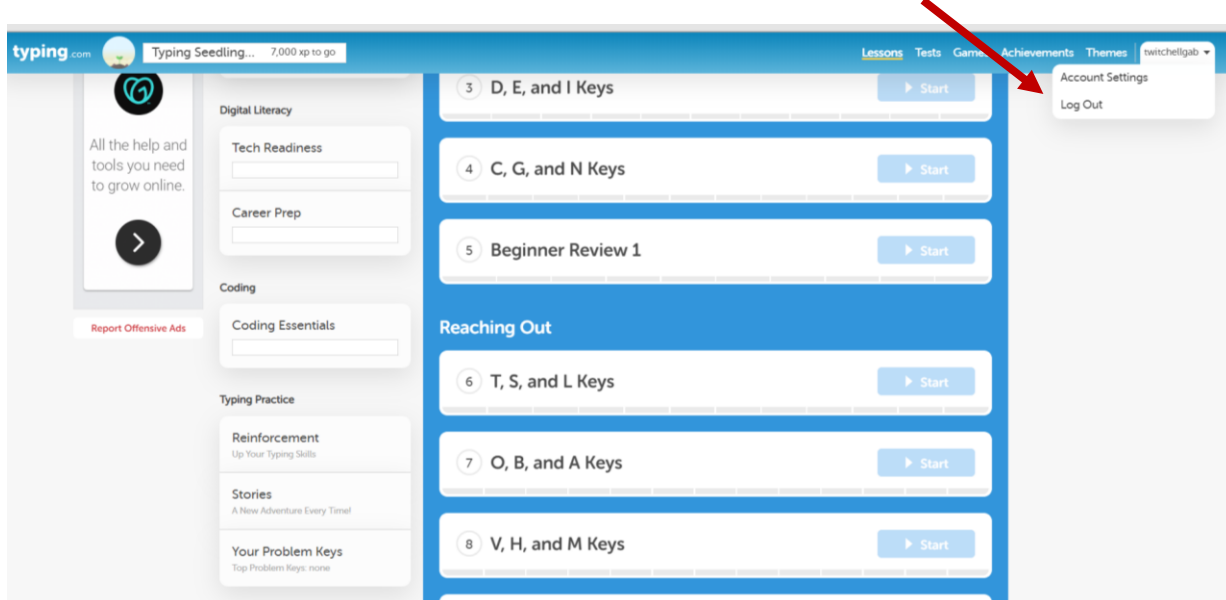
NOTE that the blue ribbon across the top is still there, with links to lessons, tests, games, etc.
