




To get to Accelerated Reader, start on the library grid page: stmarylc.org/library




For this demonstration, the student will take a test on a book he read in Epic!:



He read the book *National Geographic Readers: Sharks* by Anne Schreiber. He could not find it when he typed in the title, so he tries again with the author’s name and finds it. (At the end of this document I will show you how to look up a book’s level, quiz number, etc.)


Click on the “Take Quiz” button to the right of the screen, next to the book you would like to test on.





When you click “Finish” it will bump you into this screen. Under the heading “My Progress” are three tabs: “My Goals,” “My Certifications,” and “My Completed Work.” It comes up automatically on “My Goals.” This is where the child will be able to see her growth “flower.” It will fill with color as the child makes progress toward a goal. (Teachers will be setting goals soon.)



Select the period you want to see and click on it. Here, I've selected the entire year:

We don't really use the Certifications tab here. Click on “My Completed Work” to see a record of your child's tests and results.



Scroll down the page to see your child's quizzes and results. NOTE: you can access these reports any time you see the blue "Progress" trophy at the top right of the screen. Just click on it.




