Class Overview

This **in person** class will run from 9 am to 4 pm on Friday, February 21st. Bring a sack lunch. Coffee, water, and tea are provided free of charge. Class will be informal and focus on learning new techniques (applique paper) while engaging in the fellowship and benefits of slow stitching. There will be a **trunk show** at 7 pm that night that ALL (guild members and any other quilters) are welcome to attend. **Cost is \$65 for guild members or \$75 for non-guild members.**

Karen Styles is an Australian quilt designer who has been fabricating works of art with reproduction fabrics for the past 20 years. Karen loves stars, hexagons and medallion/frame quilts and is a Master at English Paper Piecing (EPP). Karen's quilting journey began as a teenager when she learned the basics of EPP. The quilting bug didn't gain hold until after the birth of her children when a dear friend convinced her to take some classes at a local Melbourne shop.

And as the French say, voilà, she was hooked! Karen began reproducing quilts and eventually purchased the shop that sparked her quilting rebirth! Karen loves to find unique and uncommon works to reinterpret. She adores the precision required in assembling stars (a common motif in her quilts), as well as in circular forms and hexagons. Karen is a renowned, international teacher and her inspirational personality is as bright and warm as her quilts.

Supplies Included

- A Ring of Roses Applique Quilt Pattern (30" x 32")
- Applique needles and thread will be provided.
- Hugs & Kisses Applique paper
- Coffee, water, and tea are provided free of charge.

Supplies You Bring

- Scissors for cutting out fabrics
- Elmer's glue stick or EPP glue pen.
- 1 yd background fabric
- 1 yd border fabric
- Assorted selection of fat 8ths or smaller pieces in pink x3, green, blue, gold, cream/beige x2 and 1 fat quarter cream/beige for leaves in the border. These colors are based on picture, but can be used as a guide for picking your own color choices.
- Bag lunch



Other

- Cost is \$65 for guild members or \$75 for non-guild members. Class size is limited so register quickly.
- Pop, coffee, iced tea and water are also available for purchase all day long.
- Friday, February 21st at 7 pm there will be a free trunk show for anyone interested.
