This **in person** class will run from 9 am to 4 pm on Saturday, February 22nd. Class will be informal and focused on learning new techniques while engaging in the fellowship and benefits of slow stitching. Karen loves stars, hexagons and medallion/frame quilts and is a Master at English Paper Piecing (EPP). Karen's quilting journey began as a teenager when she learned the basics of EPP. The quilting bug didn't gain hold until after the birth of her children when a dear friend convinced her to take some classes at a local Melbourne shop. And as the French say, voilà, she was hooked! Karen began reproducing quilts and eventually purchased the shop that sparked her quilting rebirth! Karen loves to find unique and uncommon works to reinterpret. She adores the precision required in assembling

Supplies Included

- Devon Circle Pattern which measures 53" x 53".
- Reusable EPP papers to make 2 blocks.
- Milliner needles and thread will be provided.
- Applique paper and elongated hexagon templates
- Coffee, water, and tea are provided free of charge.

Supplies You Bring

- Scissors for cutting out fabrics
- Elmer's glue stick or EPP glue pen.
- 2.75 yds background fabric
- 1.25 yds feature fabric for elongated hexagons, borders and binding
- An assortment of fabrics to make Devon Circles and 9-patch blocks - include fabric prints suitable to fussy-cut.
- Bag lunch



Other

- **Cost is \$65 for guild members or \$75 for non-guild members.** Class size is limited so register quickly.
- Pop, coffee, iced tea and water are also available for purchase all day long.
- **Friday, February 21st at 7 pm there will be a free trunk show for anyone interested.**
- Acrylic templates can be purchased at PaperPieces.com if you desire to use them for fussy cutting. Templates are not needed and will not be sold at the class.
