Fabric Requirements for Clam Shell Pouch

- Fat 1/8th fabric for outside of clamshell pouch
- Fat 1/8th fabric for lining of clamshell pouch
- 4" x 40" or WOF fabric for pouch binding
- 13 - 2.5" squares fabric for clamshells
- 10" x 20" scrap of batting

Fabric for Hexagon Star-a-Day

- Large assortment of colored scraps
- Large assortment of background scraps
- $\frac{2}{3}$ yard of fabric for large diamonds
- 1 yard of fabric for border hexagons
- $\frac{2}{3}$ yard of fabric for binding

Fabric for Queen's Folly

- 2.5" x 24" fabric for center diamonds
- 5" x 36" fabric for petals
- 3" x 48" fabric for small petals
- 3.5" x 48" fabric for outer leaves
- 15" x 15" background fabric to applique the completed rosette onto

Other supplies needed:

- Sharp pencil
- Fine permanent pen or marker to mark stitching lines
- Sharp fabric scissors
- Thimble if you use one
- Fine needle threader if you have one
- thread conditioner if you like to use it
- a small ruler might be helpful at times
- appliqué pins and/or regular pins
- Glue pen with extra glue sticks if you have one, otherwise we will have washable glue sticks available
