RESPECT CODE OF CONDUCT FOR SPECTATORS AND PARENTS/CARERS

We have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game.

Featherstone Flyers Football Club is supporting the FA's Respect programme to ensure football can be enjoyed in a safe, positive environment.

Please remember that children's football is a time for them to develop their technical, physical, tactical and social skills — winning isn't everything!

Play your part and observe The FA's Respect Code of Conduct for spectators, parents/carers at all times.

Whilst attending home or away matches please:

- Remember that children play for FUN
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Always respect the match official's decision
- Remain outside the field of play and within designated spectator's areas (where provided)
- Let the manager and coach do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do or getting them to take any instructions during the game.
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee and match officials
- Avoid criticising a player for making a mistake — mistakes are part of learning
- NEVER engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour

Please understand that if you do not follow the Code any or all of the following actions may be taken by the Club, County FA, League or the FA:

- Issued a verbal warning from the club or league official
- Required to meet with the Club, League or CFA welfare officer
- Required to meet with the Club Committee
- Obligated to leave the match venue by the club
- Obligated to undertake an FA education course
- Requester by the club not to attend future games
- Suspended or have your membership removed
- Required to leave the club along with any dependents

In addition:

- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and/or suspension of the Club
