Our Lenten Promise:

I will take opportunities to learn about and show generosity.

DAY 1- 18/2/26

(Ash Wednesday)

Attend an Ash Wednesday service. See our school website for Mass times. (We will do this together when we return to school, too!)

DAY 2- 19/2/26

Listen to/ read the story of 'The Widows Offering' Mark 12: 41-44
Take a moment to reflect on what this story teaches us about generosity.

DAY 3- 20/2/26

Write a card for somebody in our school telling them how special they are. Give it them on our first day back.

DAY 4- 21/2/26

Go through your toys and books at home. What can you donate to charity?

1ST SUNDAY OF LENT

Rest and reflect

DAY 5- 23/2/26

Take a compliment—use Post-it notes to cover your classroom door or window with kind words. Everybody takes a different one home.

DAY 6- 24/2/26

Take time to listen to this song: Pat Barrett 'Build My Life'. You could draw as you listen to express how the music makes you feel.

DAY 7- 25/2/26

Decorate a house moneybox to collect loose change for Whitechapel. (We will collect in the money raised at the end of our challenge)

DAY 8 - 26/2/26

Read to or play with someone younger than you.

DAY 9- 27/2/26

Make a 'Things I Like About You' book or card for someone in your class or family.

DAY 10 - 28/2/26

Leave a kind note for someone in your home- you could put it on their pillow or in their bag!

2ND SUNDAY OF LENT

Rest and reflect

DAY 11- 02/3/26

Listen to the story of Jesus feeding the 5000. John 6:1-14. What does the young boy teach us about generosity?

DAY 12- 03/3/26

Our Silver Readers offer their time to read with us. How can we thank them?

DAY 13- 04/3/26

Our wonderful PTA work so hard. Write a letter or note to tell them how thankful you are. They are a great example of generosity!

DAY 14- 05/3/26

Say hello to or chat to someone new today.

DAY 15- 06/3/26

Find opportunities to offer help. This could be opening a door, helping to carry bags or books or helping a friend find their coat.

DAY 16- 07/3/26

Deliver a card and/or a gift to a local service in Crosby. E.g local library, fire station, Nazareth House

3RD SUNDAY OF LENT

Rest and reflect

DAY 17- 09/3/26

If you see litter on our playground put it in the bin without being asked. If you see coats on the floor, put them on a peg.

DAY 18- 10/3/26

Be generous with your time; watch today's episode of Newsround; what can we pray for?

DAY 19- 11/3/26

Leave a positive note inside a book from your class library for somebody to find.

DAY 20- 12/3/26

Make a friendship bracelet for somebody in your class.

DAY 21- 13/3/26

Say a special thank you to our dinner staff when you see them today.

DAY 22- 14/3/26

Who in your life is most generous? What things do they do that are generous? What can you learn from them?

4TH SUNDAY OF LENT

Rest and reflect.

DAY 23- 16/3/26

Our office staff work so hard to keep our school organised! If you see them today, thank them in person for all of their hard work.

DAY 24- 17/3/26

Look out for children who might not have someone to play with at playtime today. Ask if they would like to play with you.

DAY 25- 18/3/26

Make somebody smile- learn a joke to tell someone in school.

DAY 26- 19/3/26

At playtime, use chalks to decorate our playground with kind words for our friends and adults to read.

DAY 27- 20/3/26

Our TAs are amazing! Make a certificate for a TA to show them how great they are!

DAY 28-21/3/26

With your adult, offer to help an elderly relative or neighbour. You could cook them a meal, or deliver a gift such as flowers or chocolates..

5TH SUNDAY OF LENT

Rest and reflect

DAY 29- 23/3/26

Make an extra effort to leave your classroom clean for our amazing cleaners. Maybe you could leave them a gift or a letter from your class too!

DAY 30- 24/3/26

When you line up in school today, let someone go ahead of you.

DAY 31- 25/3/26

Our caretakers do a great job of looking after our school building. If you see them around school, thank them in person. If you would like to draw them a picture or write a message, your teacher can pass it to them.

DAY 32- 26/3/26

Make a donation to our food bank collection today.

DAY 33- 27/3/26

Ask your teacher if there are any jobs you can help them with today.

DAY 34- 28/3/26

Give someone flowers-you could buy them, pick them from your garden or make paper flowers.

6TH SUNDAY OF LENT

Rest and reflect

DAY 35- 30/3/26

Read the story of 'The Good Samaritan' Luke 10:30-37. Reflect on what this story teaches us about generosity.

DAY 36- 31/3/26

Feed the birds or leave out a bowl of water for animals.

DAY 37- 01/4/26

Think of 3 people who inspire you; how can you thank them?

DAY 38- 02/4/26

(Maundy Thursday)
With an adult at home, help to make a meal for your family. Perhaps you could also share the story of the Last Supper.

DAY 39- 03/4/26

(Good Friday)
Take time to spread hope and joy. Draw a rainbow cross of hope and display it in a window at home where passers by will see it.

DAY 40- 03/4/26

Prayer walk-With your family, take a walk in nature. Thank God for signs of new life and ask God to help and inspire you to find ways to help the wonderful world He created.

EASTER SUNDAY 05/4/26

Attend an Easter Sunday Church service with your family to celebrate the Risen Lord! See our school website for Mass times.
