We hope that you had a lovely half term. We can't quite believe that the school year is almost over! This a newsletter to inform parents and carers about our learning this half term.

Communication, Language and Literacy

This term we will be reading the story, 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea' by Judith Kerr. We will further develop our mark-making through writing shopping lists for Sophie and Mummy and writing invitations for guests that we would like to visit us for tea! We also find out about tigers and where in the world they live.



We will revisit the phonemes s,a,t,p,i,n to support us in identifying initial and other phonemes in simple words. We will also continue to play lots of oral blending games. Have you tried these at home yet? When talking to your child you could say, 'It is time for b-e-d.' for example. I-spy is simple game for identifying initial sounds in words!

Come and See

We deliver Religious Education through the Come and See programme. This term we will be covering the topic, 'Our World'.

This Topic: learning outcomes

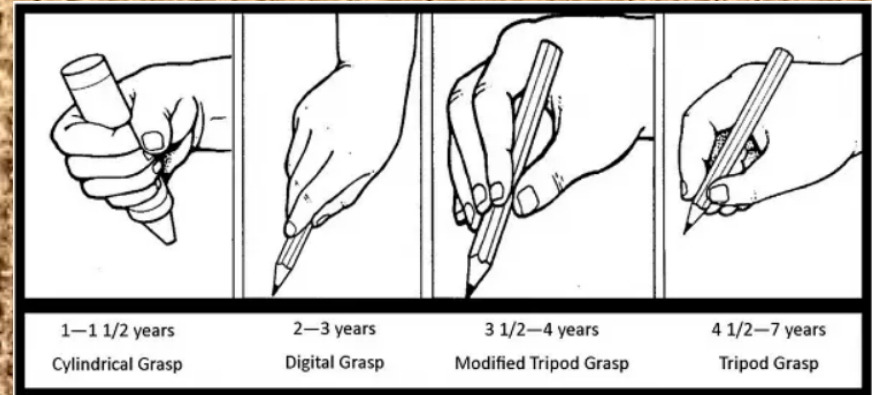
Know and understand:

Physical Development

This term, we will continue to learn how to write our own names, forming recognisable letters with good pencil control.



Mathematics

In Maths, we will be solving mathematical problems with numbers up to 5. We will explore finding 1 more and 1 less than. We will develop our mathematical language to describe the order of events in our daily routines.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

This term, we will be talking about starting school in September and about how it makes us feel. We will continue to learn how to play co-operatively with one another and how to solve problems when friendships go wrong.

Forest School

The children will continue their Forest School sessions within the school grounds. The children will care for their newly planted vegetables in the allotment and grow sunflowers. They will be observing how tall they grow and developing their mathematical skills through measuring their height and comparing them. They will celebrate all that they have enjoyed and achieved in nature by having a tasty barbeque towards the end of the term!



Expressive Arts and Design

This term, we will be exploring different materials such as clay. We will make clay faces to display on the trees in the woods and make prints.

Understanding the World

This term we will learn about other countries in our world and recognise the differences that we notice. We will develop a wider vocabulary by discussing the differences that we find.
