After downloading the app, you will be prompted to scan the QR code or enter the school name and 4-digit code.

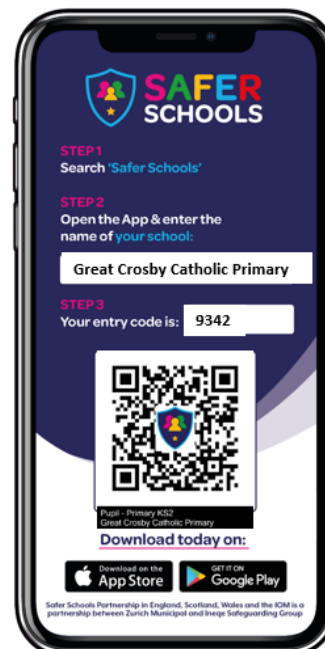
The app also links to our school website home, calendar, policies pages.
