ENGLISH

We will be continuing to focus on basic punctuation and sentence structure. We will be using the books 'The Bog Baby' and 'Grandad's Island' to begin exploring and creating their own descriptive pieces of writing.

MATHS

This term, we will be focusing on:

- money, recognising coins and notes and solving problems involving change.
- Multiplication and Division of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables
- Length and height
- Mass, capacity and temperature

SCIENCE

Our topic will be 'Animals Including Humans.' - During this topic, we will be investigating the basic needs of humans and animals, a balanced diet and how things grow.

This term, we will explore various topics in PSHE.

Living in the Wider World - People and the jobs they might do, money and the role of the internet.

Health and Wellbeing - Keeping Safe, recognising risk and rules.

COMPUTING

This term we are looking at systems and networks. We will be learning about the I.T. that is all around us.

GEOGRAPHY

Our topic is 'Why is our world wonderful? We will be identifying and locating characteristics of the UK on a map. We will also be identifying human and physical features.

HISTORY

Our History topic this term is 'The lives of significant individuals: The Monarchy'. We will be learning about and comparing the lives of Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth II.

ART

Our art topic this half term is 'Expressive Painting' exploring how artists mix colours and use painting in an explorative and gestural way.

P.E.

Our PE days are Wednesdays and Thursdays. Please ensure the children come into school on these days wearing the school P.E. kit for our PE lessons.

Our PE topics this term are Striking and Fielding and Team building.

MUSIC

For our music curriculum we will be Singing. We will be learning folk songs and creating sounds to represent three contrasting landscapes: seaside, countryside and city.
