These were known as **Maat**  
and were governed by a feather,  
the symbol of the goddess Maat.

This "weighing of the heart"  
ceremony was recorded in Chapter  
125 of "The Book of the Dead".  
The ceremony was judged  
by 43 gods and was witnessed  
by Osiris, King of the Underworld.
