Happy Easter and here is to a happy and healthy summer term in the sun! Here is a overview of our curriculum for the Summer term including dates for the diary and key information.

Key information

In Year1 the children enter through their classroom external doors in the mornings at **8:35am** and the school day finishes at **3:10pm**. Children will be dismissed from the KS1 playground.

PE is on a **Monday** and **Thursday**. (**Monday indoor, Thursday outdoor)** Please ensure that your child comes to school in their PE kit. This is a yellow t- shirt, a pair of navy or black shorts or joggers for the colder months and a school jumper, cardigan or plain navy/black hoodie. (We kindly ask that they do not wear any branded clothing).

Religious Education

In Year 1, we follow the new Religious Education Directory Curriculum 'To Know You More Clearly'. During the first half term, we will learn about Pentecost in our R.E. topic 'To the Ends of the Earth'. After the half term, we learn about out local church and parish during the topic 'Dialogue and Encounter'.

Mathematics

We will be following the White Rose Maths Schemes of Learning. This term, our units of work are as follows:

- Multiplication and Division
- Fractions
- Geometry (position and direction)
- Place Value (Within 100)
- Measurement- Money & Time

We also follow the NCETM Mastering Number material to support our children in developing mathematical fluency.

English

Alongside our History topic learning bout the Titanic, we will be writing our own Information Text about the events of the disaster and the links it shares with Liverpool.

We will also be exploring diversity through the story Sulwe where the children have the chance to retell the story and change and adapt the tale when they publish their own version.



Phonics
