Happy New Year and welcome back Year One!

Here is a overview of our curriculum for the Spring term including dates for the diary and key information.

Key information

In Year1 the children enter through their classroom external doors in the mornings at **8:35am** and the school day finishes at **3:10pm**. Children will be dismissed from the KS1 playground.

PE is on a **Monday** and **Thursday**. (**Monday indoor, Thursday outdoor)** Please ensure that your child comes to school in their PE kit. This is a yellow t- shirt, a pair of navy or black shorts or joggers for the colder months and a school jumper, cardigan or plain navy/black hoodie. (We kindly ask that they do not wear any branded clothing).

Religious Education

In Year 1, we follow the new Religious Education Directory Curriculum 'To Know You More Clearly'. In *Galilee to Jerusalem* we learn about the life and ministry of Jesus and in *Desert to Gar*den we learn about Holy Week and Jesus' death and resurrection.

Mathematics

We will be following the White Rose Maths Schemes of Learning. This term, our units of work are as follows:

- Place value (Within 20)
- Addition and Subtraction (Within 20)
- Measurement, Length and Height
- Place Value (Within 50)
- Measurement, Mass and Volume

We also follow the NCETM Mastering Number material to support our children in developing mathematical fluency.

English

We will start the term by looking at the Traditional Tale, 'The Gingerbread Man' and having our own gingerbread

man picnic! You can support this unit by reading a range of traditional tales and stories that contain repeated phrases.

In non-fiction writing, we will be learning how to write a recount. You could help

your child to orally retell events with you such as a fun day out. After half term, we will study and perform poems and learn how to write our own instructions.

Phonics

In Year 1 we continue to follow Little Wandle Letters and Sounds. Please familiarise yourself with the 'For Parents' section of the website at https://

www.littlewandlelettersandsounds.org.uk/resources/forparents/ This term, we will continue with Phase 5, learning the alternative graphemes for each phoneme (sound).

Reminders
