YEAR 6 REVISED HOMEWORK ROUTINE

14th November 2023

Dear Parent/Carer,

We will begin a revised homework routine this week, following the arrival of the new CGP SAT buster books which were discussed with you at our recent parents evenings. Thank you to all those who have kindly paid for the purchase of these books, it is very much appreciated.

All children will receive copies of the books.

The routine is now as follows:

Monday (no change) - **Spellings** on Edshed - test the following Monday

Tuesday (no change) - **Manga High** maths assignment (changed weekly) linked to maths objectives being followed in class that week

Wednesday (no change) - **Maths** homework, to be returned the following Wednesday

Thursday (change) - **Reading CGP book** - children should complete one test per week and ensure they return it and have their homework ready to mark each Thursday

Friday (change) - **SPAG CGP book** - children should complete one double page, not a complete test, each week and ensure they return it and have their homework ready to mark each Friday.

We cannot issue replacement books, so if books are misplaced or lost, then we would have to ask you to kindly replace them.

Every Monday, we ask the children to write their homework for the forthcoming week in their **homework diary**. This will be even more important now, as we will tell them to write down the relevant pages from the CGP books so they know exactly which ones to do.

Therefore, can we ask for your support in ensuring that your child has their diary in school **every Monday**.

We really want our homework routine to support your child in making the best progress they can this year and to help secure all objectives set in class.

We also hope that by giving your child one week to complete each homework task, we have alleviated the possibility of homework causing stress or difficulty to complete.

However, please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher if you have any questions regarding the homework routine.
