## Fantasy Premier League

Dear Parents / Carers,

I have once again signed up for a private league within the Premier League official website, operated by the FA, starting on Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> October. There is no charge. We present Manager of the Month certificates throughout the season to players in these categories: Infants, Y3/Y4, Y5/6, Friends and Family and Staff.

The website cannot be accessed in school, so pupils, parents, family members, carers and staff will need to register at home. I recommend that for pupils, a parent/carer's email address is used. You will be asked for a parent/guardian's email address anyway, so that an approval email can be sent.

These are the instructions: Go to the Premier League website <https://fantasy.premierleague.com>

In the Register to Play Fantasy Premier League box, click on 'Sign Up Now'.

You will then be asked a series of questions; only the ones with an asterisk\* are required. You will be asked about receiving communications from clubs and companies. You can leave them blank. You will need to read and accept the Terms and Conditions.

You will be prompted to enter your team, using these basic rules:

Select a fantasy football squad of 15 players, consisting of:

2 Goalkeepers, 5 Defenders, 5 Midfielders, 3 Forwards

The total value of your initial squad must not exceed £100 million.

You can select up to 3 players from a single team and change the formation using the arrows.

Once you have selected your team, you can join the school league - **Great Crosby Catholic Primary:**

Below the Global Leagues box, click on the link '>Create and join leagues'.

Click on 'Join a league' then 'Join private league'. Enter the 'Private league code': **zhwamc**

I recommend that you look in the HELP section of the Fantasy Premier League website for more information, including terms and conditions, rules and how points are scored.

You and your children can also join the league if you already have a team registered on the website. If you took part last year and you have a team this year, you may have been entered automatically. Please check your accounts.
