

## Lesson six.

### The lesson plan.

Give children a copy of an ordnance survey map (see the pdf or use an ordnance survey map you may have at home) and ask them to say what they have found out about them just by making observations. Explain what each bit is e.g. contours, symbols etc.

Watch powerpoint "Lesson 1 map symbols"

Intro/ recap on the term aerial map. Show the one of Coronation park in Crosby and discuss what it tells us about Coronation Park.

On the aerial view of Crosby village (please print out), children to add symbols for the places they can see on the map. The symbols used on google maps have been blanked out e.g. for cafes, use a cup symbol; churches, use a cross symbol; schools, use a child symbol. Children to make their own symbols e.g. for cafes, schools, churches etc.

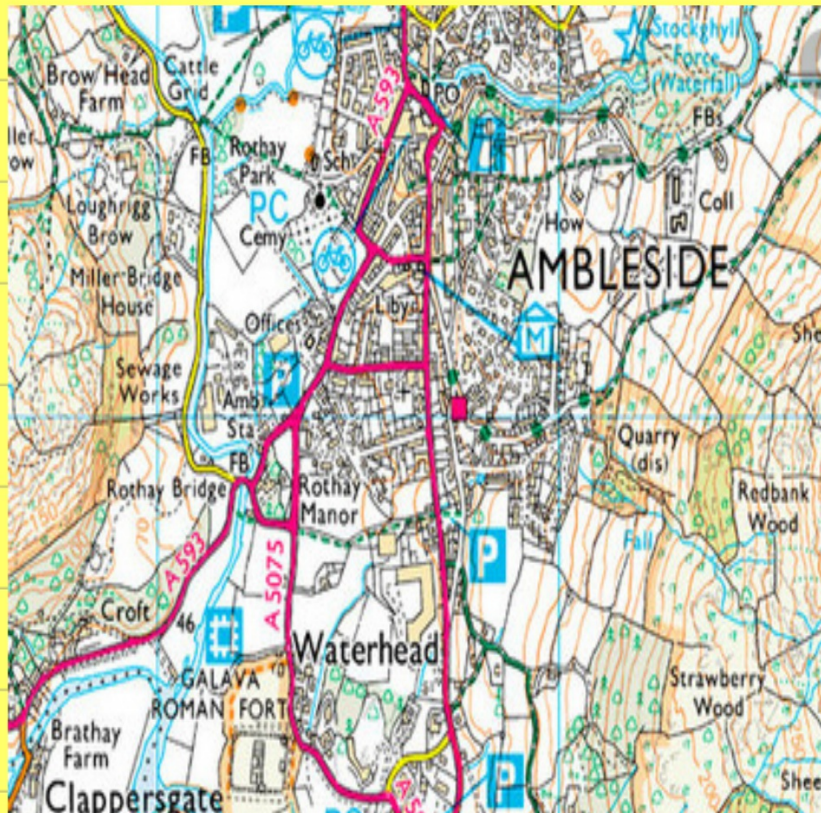
