Increasing our standard number March 2019

History of Numbers

- 2010 standard number for admission was 90. Following three years unable to offer places to our baptised catholic children living in our parishes nor siblings from outside catchment
- 2013 Approached by LA to increase admission number to 105 – 31/2 forms of entry

2014 Building program

- Fully funded by LA
- 2.5 million pounds refurbishment
- Challenges of organising 31/2 forms of entry
- Governors agreed to provide 4 classes in Early years and Key stage 1 financial implications for us as we were funding an additional teacher
- KS2 classes set to be 35 plus support

2018 offer from LA

- Still a shortfall of school places in Crosby
- We were having to take additional pupils into Reception and Years 1 and 2 as we were not 30 per class
- Potential for classes to be larger than 35 going forward
- LA then approached us to increase each year by additional 15 pupils beginning in September 2020
- They would fund further build completely

What are we going to get?

- Further three classrooms fully fitted and to same spec as our other classrooms
- Extension to hall and kitchen
- Resource room
- Extension to admin block
- 10 additional car parking places
- Internal pathway inside school grounds from Endbutt Lane

Advantage or challenge?

- Both
- It will be logistically challenging
- Playtimes' and lunchtime will have to be reviewed and possibly changed
- Need to look at how we organise events
- We take control of numbers secure that we cannot exceed four forms of entry even if parents appeal
- Single year groups throughout school no vertical groupings or large classes moving forward
- Secure route into school from Endbutt Lane
- Secure current jobs
