## Covid Alert

We have attached the new guidance on testing and isolation from Public Health Sefton. Please note that a negative LFT is not sufficient for your child to return to school if they have symptoms.

Please remember to inform school if your child has had a positive PCR or LFT on [covidalert@gcp.org.uk](mailto:covidalert@gcp.org.uk) - please provide symptom type, symptom onset date, and date of PCR/LFT test.
