

Medical Information

Sickness

If your child is suffering from sickness or diarrhoea, please keep them at home for 48 hours after the illness has ceased. If your child is going to be absent, please text to inform school on 07860003244 and provide a reason. If your child is unwell in school we will contact you, so please ensure we have two up to date contact numbers.

Inhalers and Medicines

If your child requires an inhaler, please ensure we have one in school that is in date and clearly labelled with your child's name. You will also need to complete an Individual Healthcare Plan available from the school office. If your child requires medicine during the school day, it must be provided as originally dispensed and labelled with your child's name, dosage required and storage guidelines. A permission to administer medicine form needs to be completed, available from the school office.

Bumps and falls

If your child has had a minor bump/fall in school an accident slip will be completed to inform you of the incident, detailing the first aid given. If your child has had a bump to the head, school will inform you via a phone call or text message.

Welcome

At Great Crosby we have two Nursery classes where children are encouraged to learn through indoor and outdoor play. We aim to give children a broad and balanced curriculum in which they are actively involved and interested, through a safe and secure environment.



Starting Nursery

In order to support your child's initial transition into Nursery we have arranged both a drop-in session and a home visit.

Drop-in

On Thursday 23rd June, we are holding a drop-in session between 4-6pm. You are welcome to come along with your child to come and visit our nursery setting and meet your child's class teacher and nursery support staff.

Home visits

An appointment has been arranged for you and your child to meet with your child's class teacher and support staff.

Initial settling in period

At Great Crosby we stagger the children's entry over two weeks to ensure a smooth start to Nursery and enable the children to get to know our routines and staff. Please refer to your information pack which informs you which group your child is in.

The Nursery day

Arrival We ask that your child comes into Nursery independently. They can then put their own belongings away. Your child will have their own labelled peg and a place for their water bottle and lunch bag in the classroom.

Lunchtime Your child will require a healthy packed lunch. We ask that the children do not have nuts, chocolate or sweets. Grapes should be cut into quarters. A member of the Nursery staff as well as additional lunch time supervisors will oversee the children during lunch.

Home time Children will be dismissed via the Nursery doors at 3.00pm. We ask that you queue and wait for your child's name to be called. If your child is being collected by a different adult at the end of the day, please notify a member of staff on arrival. Please also notify school if there are any changes during the day on 0151 924 8661.

What does my child need?

Wellies and waterproof coat

Please provide a warm, waterproof coat for your child. They will also need a pair of wellies which can be left in school. We access the outdoor area in all weathers so it is important that the children have the appropriate clothing.

Change of clothing

It is helpful if you could provide your child with a change of underwear, spare socks and clothing in their book bag should they require changing for any reason.

Water bottle

Please provide your child with a labelled water bottle that they may bring into nursery each day. Please ensure that only water is put inside your child's water bottle.

Book wallet

We ask that your child has a book wallet for Nursery. Your child will bring a book home from our class library to share with you. The book wallet can also be used to keep their spare clothing in. We ask that you check your child's book wallet each day as it may contain letters or other information from school. Book wallets can be purchased from the school office for £5.50.

Snack money

Snack money is £1.50 per child, each week. Children are provided with a snack each morning and afternoon in nursery. The money also contributes towards providing enhancements to the curriculum such as purchasing seeds to grow our own vegetables in our garden. We collect snack money each half term and we will inform you when it is due.
