

Who did Rainbow Fish ask for help? How did Rainbow Fish make friends? How did Rainbow Fish feel at the end of the story and why? Did he find it easy to share his scales? Can you write some words to describe the sea, and rainbow fish in the story? Try to make a repeating pattern with the shapes and colours of your scales. Keep your fish for the activity on Tuesday.</p> 	<p>Understanding of The World</p> <p>Link with 'Come and See' topic about God's wonderful world</p> <p>Plant some seeds it could be flowers, vegetables or herbs and think about how we have to care for it. Think about what your seed needs to grow into a healthy plant. Can you look after your plant each day?</p> <p>Perhaps you could keep a little diary and draw and write about how your plant is growing.</p>

Can you name the sea creatures that Rainbow Fish met? Write a list of your favourite sea creatures. You may have seen some sea creatures at the beach or in the aquarium.</p>	<p>Mathematics Sing The counting down from 20 song https://youtu.be/fS6OrraBhz4</p> <p>You are going to measure your Rainbow Fish. Can you put a button/penny around the outline of the fish? How many did you use? Write down how many. What will happen if you change the buttons size? Can you predict what will happen if you use a smaller or larger size fish? Use your buttons to measure how long and how wide your fish is. Write down your measurements. How many buttons will you need to cover the whole of your fish?</p>	<p>Expressive Arts & Design</p> <p>Who did rainbow fish meet in the story? Can you make some stick puppets of the characters in the story? You could draw the characters and decorate them and then stick them on a straw or lolly stick. Use your stick puppets to retell the story.</p>
