Dear Parent/Carer,

We would like to invite your child to attend two Year 5 Transition Days. On Friday 7th June pupils in Year 5 will visit the Academy to participate in a Science STEM Day. Pupils will get the opportunity to develop their enquiry skills through a series of exciting secondary based practical activities. The children will be accompanied by their primary school teachers and pupils will be required to wear their school uniform on this day.

On Wednesday 29th May 2024, from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. We will be running an activity day which has been designed to focus on helping pupils become more familiar with Sacred Heart's surroundings and promote teamwork and a sense of community. It will be an enjoyable experience where children will have fun, learn new skills, and make new connections with future pupils and staff at Sacred Heart. The day will follow the pattern of our school day with team building and fun activities happening each "lesson". This will run during the half term holiday and the children will not be required to wear their school uniform. However, we advise them to wear clothing that will be suitable for physical movement as they will have the opportunity to enjoy time on inflatables, a session exploring and learning about Circus Skills, and much more. Children should report to reception at 8:50 a.m. for a 9:00 am.

School will provide drinks, snacks and lunch on both days. Please indicate on the form overleaf if your child has any dietary requirements. There will be no charge for these events.

Occasionally, school takes photographs of events and students at Sacred Heart Catholic Academy. We may also make recordings in video, CCTV or through webcam.

From time to time, we are invited to provide articles or photographs for publications when sharing our good practice across Pope Francis Catholic Multi Academy Trust, Sefton Local Authority, and the Archdiocese of Liverpool. Often, there is good news to celebrate, which the local press would like to report or which we would like to include on our website, in our prospectus or other printed materials. e.g. a successful team achievement, a competition win, an individual achievement etc.
