> Draw a fish shape. You will need a body, a tail, fins, scales and an eye. Can you colour and decorate your fish?

Read the story 'The Rainbow Fish' by Marcus Pfister. You can find it on You Tube. What did rainbow fish share? How did he make many friends?

Can you measure your fish? Have a guess how many buttons or pennies do you think would fit around the outside of your fish?

Measure your fish by placing buttons or pennies all the way around and count how many you needed. How long is your fish? How wide is it? Use your pennies or buttons to help you. Listen to or read the story 'The snail and the Whale'

Can you draw a map of some of the wonderful things the snail and the whale saw on their journey? Write some labels on your map. A game to play.

Ask your adult to place some objects on a tray no more than 10 at first. Cover them with a cloth. Can you guess how many are there without counting? Now check to see if you are right! Have another go with different amounts of objects.



Listen to the story 'One is a Snail, Ten is a Crab.' How many legs can you see on each page? Can you count them?




How many legs if there were two dogs?

Ladybird Doubles.

Draw a ladybird with 3 spots on one side of its body. Can you use a mirror to find double the number of spots? See how many different Ladybird doubles you can do!

Remember to use a mirror to find the doubles!

Number

To secure number recognition and understanding within 20 through counting and ordering numbers. Work on addition and subtraction and number bonds within 10. Learn to count in 2s, 5s and 10s (Jack Hartmann on YouTube is useful for counting in 2's, 5's and 10's), find number doubles and halves of numbers, (See YouTube Double/Doubles I can Add Doubles and Doubles Addition Facts)

Revise 2D and 3D shapes, you could go on a shape hunt around your house.

(The Singing Walrus 3D shape song is worth a watch on Youtube)

Revise Phase 3 letter sounds including digraphs e.g. ai, tail, oa, goat, ow, cow, er, farmer, ar, farm, or, horse, oi, coin, oo, moon and names of letters and letter formation. Consolidate tricky words taught so far and move onto the following Phase 4 Tricky words: **said, have, like, so, do, some, come, were, there, little, one, when, out, what.** Can you write Phase 3 and 4 tricky words? (Youtube-Mr Thorne does phonics-Mr T's phonics, Tricky word songs- Epic Learners, Little Learners)

Look at Pobble 365/Once Upon a Picture, write your own simple sentences about what you can see.

Don't forget - capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.
