Our topics will be:

- Spread the Word
- Rules
- Treasures

English

This term we will be studying Emily Davison and Rosa Parks and writing letters and newspaper articles about their lives. We will also be preparing and completing the statutory

Year 2 assessments. During the second half term we will be studying 2 books, "The Proudest Blue" by Ibtihaj Muhammad and "Wisp" by Zana Fraillon and Grahame Baker-Smith.

These English topics will also involve aspects of Science, History, Art, Design Technology, Music and Drama.

Maths

Our focus will be:

- counting in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s
- place value of 2-digit numbers
- partitioning numbers
- addition, subtraction, multiplication and division
- 2 step word problems and puzzles
- measure including money and time

We will also be preparing and completing the statutory Year 2 assessments.

Science

Our topics will be:

- Plants
- Animals including Humans

<u>History</u>

The children will research and learn about Emily Davison and Rosa Parks and we will link this to our writing. We will also be learning about the Great Fire of London.

Design Technology

The children will be designing and building moving fire engines.

<u> PE</u>

Our topics for the summer term are:

- Target Games
- Athletics
- Gymnastics

Computing

The children will continue to develop their programming and coding skills to make music.





How can you help?

English

Please continue to encourage your child to read a range of books and genre and perhaps even take a trip to the local library.

Provide some purposeful opportunities to write; checking for basic punctuation and spelling errors.

Maths

Encourage children to learn number facts (times tables, number bonds). Use these in real life situations in and around home alongside other puzzles and problems as well as measure problems including time and money.

Science

Research what plants need to live.

Research different life cycles of animals

<u>Came and See</u> Spread the Word

Try to visit church and think of different ways we can spread important messages.

Rules

Think about the different rules we have in our daily lives, what happens when we do/don't follow them? How do we feel?

Treasures

Think about all of the things we treasure in God's wonderful world. How many of these could you see on your walk to the shops or to school?

Research the events and create a timeline. You could also practise writing diary entries by keeping your own diary and thinking about how we can use our senses to enhance our writing (what could you hear/see/feel/smell/taste?).
