

COME AND SEE

- explain that there are different forces at play in everyday life such as gravity, friction, air and water resistance;

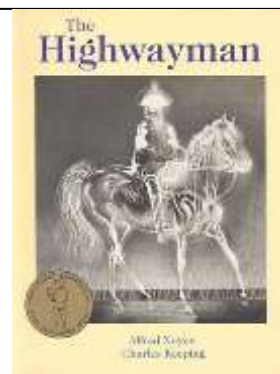
ENGLISH
