PGL Boreatton Park- Final Preparations

Dear Parents/Carers,

Our residential trip is just over a week away and excitement is building.

The following points are a guide to help with the final preparations.

Please arrive at school at normal time and take cases/holdall bags into classrooms. We are hoping to leave as close to 09.00am as possible and therefore you are welcome to wave us off at the school gate.

Please remember when packing to use the clothing check list and only bring one small suitcase/holdall which your child can carry. Do not pack medicines in the suitcase as these will need to be clearly labelled, with written instructions when to administer, and handed to class teachers. Any travel sickness tablets can be given at home prior to the trip, if required for the return journey, please give to class teachers clearly labelled.

If your child has an inhaler please make sure it is labelled and the children should keep that in their pocket and a spare handed in.

We have compiled a medical and dietary list from the forms you completed. Any medicines that you stated on the medical forms needs to be handed in on the morning. If you need to discuss this with us please do so before hand to avoid any last minute delays.

We ask that the children come ready for activities and they must bring a waterproof coat. It is advisable to wear old clothes, please do not buy any new clothes for the trip. We do ask that you label all the children's' clothes.

On the kit list, a day bag or rucksack is included. The children, if they wish, could carry this around and put their water bottle in (or inhaler) or a disposable camera if they wish. It is not compulsory.

The children must bring indoor shoes (sliders/slippers) as PGL insist on indoor shoes. They need 2 pairs of outdoor shoes (old trainers or walking boot) plus a plastic bag to put the wet items in.

The children are taking part in water activities hence the need for the second pair of shoes.

PGL have again asked us to remind you that aerosols are forbidden as they can trigger the fire alarm sensors.

Children should not bring any electronic devices/mobile phones, sweets or money. They are permitted to bring a teddy/book to read of an evening. Cameras are permitted as mentioned, but only disposable ones.

School will update the website and social media (internet connection permitting!) of the children over the course of the trip. Children are due back at 15:15 and should be collected from the classroom doors. If we are late we will send messages out.

Could you please make sure you are up to date with payments for the trip and your balance has been paid.
