Oct. 6-9	Charles DeMuth's "I saw the figure 5 in Gold" inspires our leaf paintings. We create space by repeating prints of different size leaves, and using metallic paint. Also, the Aboriginal Australian artists.	Keeping rhythm in 4/4 time, while splitting the class to keep double time. Oct. 20-23	Clay Tiled Mosaics: a look at the ancient Roman mosaics that are still being discovered in Italy today! We will make a clay tile and press small colored tiles in to make a design.	Name that tune! Children will use their ears and our tuned wood blocks to identify different notes. Common melody competition: Be the first to name that tune played on the keyboard!	Gingerbread cookies: let's cut shapes with this traditional colonial recipe. Ghost shapes, and boy and girl shapes. If all goes well...;) the kids should have some to take home and share.
Oct. 27-30	Community and Public Art: Let's brainstorm ideas for a public mural that we will all begin in November! What kinds of things do people want to see on their streets of Fredericksburg?	Drum Circle Fun. Let's enjoy the cooperative and creative activity of making beats together. A liberating and unifying experience that is truly timeless!	Origami! Let's make multiple origami animals. If time allows, we will create enough to make a simple art mobile with the creations!
